

PLUMBER

POSITION OVERVIEW

This role is responsible for installing and repairing water systems in residential or commercial buildings, including water connections to troughs and systems on the town common, and the wash-down bay, as well as with pipework damaged during road construction and maintenance.

Duties include studying and analysing blueprints and drawings to identify plumbing and water supply systems to assemble and install products without interfering with existing infrastructure. Other general tasks include measuring, cutting, bending pipe material and installing and maintaining water systems.

Good candidates for this position often possess a strong understanding of plumbing systems, materials and equipment and are excellent at troubleshooting and analysing water system errors. Due to the nature of the job, the ability to squat, kneel, stand, bend or twist for long periods of time is required along with the flexibility to travel to locations.

KEY OUTCOMES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF POSITION

- 1) Study and analyse blueprints and floor plans to understand the plumbing system and water supply system layout;
- 2) Navigate the assembly and installation of pipes and tubes without interfering with existing infrastructure;
- 3) Measure, cut and bend pipe material including assembling valves, fittings, tubes and water system appliances;
- 4) Repair, replace, troubleshoot and/or install and maintain:
 - a. Heating and ventilation systems;
 - b. Sanitary plumbing (sewer and waste disposal) as well as plumbing within the water treatment plant;
 - c. Drainage/Roofing;
 - d. Gas fitting;
 - e. Water reticulation;
 - f. Pipe installations; and
 - g. Ductwork fixing.
- 5) Maintain current knowledge of state regulations affecting plumbing work.

SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE, EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

- 1) Qualified licenced plumber with 2+ years post apprenticeship experience working as a plumber in a fast-paced environment;
- 2) Strong understanding of plumbing systems, material and equipment with excellent troubleshooting and analytical skills;
- 3) Working knowledge of state regulations affecting plumbing work;
- 4) Exceptional customer service and client focus;
- 5) Ability to follow and understand written and verbal directions;
- 6) Demonstrate a responsible attitude in relation to time keeping and personal organisation;
- 7) Demonstrate personal motivation and initiative;
- 8) Willingness to travel and carry out duties in varied workplaces and conditions;
- 9) Ability to pas police/criminal history check (as relevant);
- 10) Ability to pass medical, drug and alcohol testing (as relevant); and
- 11) Fitness to perform requirements of the position without risk.
