CRYSTAL TRUMPETERS

The story of the original Jericho and the biblical heritage is told through the symbolic monument that's called 'Crystal Trumpeters'. The structure is based on the Bible stories of the Israelites and the town of Jericho as described in the Old Testament book of Joshua.

REDBANK PARK

COACH – Rockhampton *Collection/drop off point – Jericho Store*

Paradise Coaches travel twice a week (Tue & Sat) from Jericho to Barcaldine with connections to Greyhound Australia (GX 494) overnight service to Brisbane. For the return journey from Brisbane Greyhound Australia (GX493) (Tue & Sat) overnight service to Barcaldine connects with Paradise Coaches (Wed & Sun) to Jericho.

Greyhound Australia has a daily service from Brisbane to Mt Isa and return. Coaches depart Brisbane and travels overnight and arriving the following morning.
