Barcaldine Regional Council collects your personal information with the *Animal Management (Cats & Dogs) Act 2008* in order to assess your application for animal registration and will be stored according to the *Privacy Act 2009* in a secure document management system as authorised under the *s.26 of the Public Records Act 2002*, *The Information Privacy and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2023 (IPOLA)* and updates for the disposal of common and administrative public records created by all public authorities.

Dog Registration Information

- All domestic dogs over the age of 12-weeks must be registered with Barcaldine Regional Council
- Two (2) dogs are permitted per designated household or one (1) per unit (multi-dwelling) within the designated animal control area of Alpha, Aramac, Barcaldine, Jericho and Muttaborra (as per Council Resolution April 2017)
- Registration should not be confused with microchipping. These are two (2) separate forms of animal identification
- Microchipping of all domestic dogs came into effect in Barcaldine Regional Council in 2020; and is a requirement for all dogs that are born since that date, sold or given away. If the microchip number cannot be provided at the time of registration, the owner will receive a notice.
- It is the responsibility the owner/s to provide the minimum standards for keeping animals
- It is the responsibility the owner/s to provide a proper enclosure and not let the dog wander or cause a nuisance
- The owner of the dog/s must advise Barcaldine Regional Council within 14 business days of any changes to the information provided on this Registration Application
- Dog Registration is non-refundable and non-transferrable
- Desexed and Microchipped Dogs – have the option of either a 1 year term or a Lifetime term for the dog. Please indicate on the front of this form
