WHY SORT?

Sorting your materials before arriving:



Saves time onsite



Makes unloading easier



Improves recycling



Reduces landfill



Helps recover reusable materials

HOW IT WORKS?

1



SORT AT HOME

Separate your materials before loading your trailer or vehicle.

2



GROUP YOUR LOAD

Keep similar materials together to make unloading quicker and easier.

3



LOAD IN REVERSE ORDER

Load your trailer so the last items loaded are the first to be unloaded.

We recommend loading in this order:

1

Cardboard – Clean, flattened

2

General Waste

3

Green Waste – Palms and logs, mulch, small branches and clean soil

4

Construction & Demolition (C&D) – Tin roofing, timber, pallets, soft materials and hard materials

5

Metals – Large appliances, solar panels, steel and aluminium

6

Furniture – Items suitable for reuse

7

Tyres

Used Motor Oil & Car Batteries

WHAT CAN I SORT AT THE WTS?



CLEAN DIRT: Clean soil only
No rocks, bricks, concrete or contaminated material



MULCH: Mulch only. Place in the designated mulch bay



SMALL BRANCHES: Small branches and garden prunings only



PALM FRONDS & LOGS: Large green waste only.



C&D SOFT: Gyprock, non-asbestos cement sheeting and other soft construction materials.



C&D HARD: Concrete, bricks, stones, tiles, toilets, basins, sinks and other masonry materials.



C&D PALLET & WOOD: Separate untreated timber, treated timber and pallets.



C&D TIN ROOF: Corrugated roofing iron and metal sheeting only.



METALS (STEEL & ALUMINIUM)

General scrap steel, aluminium and other metal products.



SOLAR PANELS: Place all solar panels on the designated pallets.



WHITE GOODS: Refrigerators, freezers, washing machines and other large household appliances.



TYRES: Place vehicle tyres in the designated tyre skip bin.



REUSABLES & FURNITURE: furniture and household items suitable for reuse.



BEVERAGE CONTAINERS: Donated to Barcaldine Age Care.



USED MOTOR OIL & CONTAINERS: Empty used motor oil into the collection tank.



Leave empty oil containers on the adjacent pallets.



CAR BATTERIES: Place car batteries on the designated pallet.



DOMESTIC CARDBOARD: Use the 3,000 L bins. Flatten boxes and remove plastic, tape and polystyrene.



Commercial cardboard should be flattened and placed in the two skip bins on the right hand side of the bridge



GENERAL WASTE: On the right side of the Bridge: all type of plastics, Polysterene, foan, Furniture that can not be reuse by others, Household general waste
